

Notice for Family and Friends of Prisoners Regarding Visits and Deliveries of Cash, Foods and Necessities at the Wuling Minimum-Security Prison, Agency of Corrections, Ministry of Justice

1. Visiting Registration Time

- (1) Monday to Friday: 8:30 AM to 11:00 AM, 1:30 PM to 4:00 PM
- (2) First Sunday of every month: 8:30 AM to 11:00 AM, 1:30 PM to 4:00 PM

2. Visit Eligibility and Frequency

(1) Eligibility:

Prisoners at Level 4 may receive visits from relatives.

Prisoners at Level 3 and above may receive visits from non-relatives.

Prisoners not subject to progressive treatment have no restrictions on visit eligibility.

(2) Frequency:

Level 1: No restrictions.

Level 2: Once every 3 days.

Level 3: Once or twice a week.

Level 4: and prisoners not subject to progressive treatment: Once a week (any day), with each visit lasting up to 30 minutes.

(3) Restrictions on Visit Applications

No visits allowed if:

- 1) The applicant lacks identification documents.
- 2) The applicant is intoxicated or mentally unstable.
- 3) The visit is not registered.

- 4) The applicant's behavior is suspicious or they are impersonating someone else.
- 5) The visit is not for official purposes and the prisoner refuses the visit.

(4) Prohibited Items and Behaviors During Visits

- 1) Use of mobile phones, cameras, camcorders, and other dangerous or prohibited items is forbidden.
- 2) Visits may be terminated if disciplinary rules are violated.

(5) Delivery of Cash

Cash delivery is limited to New Taiwan Dollar cash, postal money orders, or cashier's checks from domestic financial institutions; once per day, up to NT\$10,000 per delivery.

(6) Delivery of Food Items

Types of food allowed: dishes, fruits, cakes, cookies.

- 1) Once every three days, not exceeding 2 kilograms per delivery.
- 2) Only cooked food is allowed. Raw vegetables, meat, and sashimi are prohibited. Fruits must be pre-cut for inspection. Spoiled or unfresh food will be returned or discarded. Deliveries without accompanying visits must meet the same eligibility conditions as those for visits.

(7) Delivery of Medication

The delivery of medication requires a doctor's prescription. The sender shall provide a guarantee and a copy of his/her identification card.
