

#### 4. Public Welfare Rehabilitation Internship Complex Café



In 2018, the "Wuling Café" was established to serve the public. To imbue it with a new inspirational meaning, it was renamed the "Public Welfare Rehabilitation Internship Complex Café," where dedicated "students" serve visitors.

Every year, professional instructors are hired to teach prisoners production skills, allowing them to experience real workplace service and environmental safety knowledge during their sentence. They improve their skills in baking various desserts, bread, cooking delicious dishes, brewing aromatic Wuling Café, and preparing the fragrant black-feathered "bucket chicken."



Next to the café, there is an art and culture exhibition area, providing a space for art and legal education for visitors and nearby middle and elementary schools. It also offers the best souvenirs, including the prison's high-quality products such as native eggs, chicken essence, shredded chicken, coffee beans, pineapple cakes, and handmade cookies.
