

Multiple Channels for Accepting Public Complaints and Reports

1. On-Site Reports:

The Agency Against Corruption (AAC) under the Ministry of Justice has dedicated personnel in the investigation teams in the northern, central, and southern regions to handle on-site reports. The service hours are from 08:30 to 12:30 and 13:30 to 17:30 on working days.

2. Telephone Reports:

An 0800 toll-free hotline is available for public complaints and reports. The number is "0800-286-586" (0800-You Report, I Report). The hotline service hours are from 08:30 to 12:30 and 13:30 to 21:30 on working days, and from 08:30 to 12:30 and 13:30 to 17:30 on weekends and national holidays.

3. Written Reports:

Written reports can be sent to P.O. Box "100006, National History Museum Post Office, Box No. 153."

4. Fax Reports:

Reports can be faxed to the dedicated fax line "02-23811234."

5. Online Reports:
